New Self-Identification Disability Requirements for Apprenticeship Programs

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Sponsors of apprenticeship programs with five or more apprentices will soon be required to invite all applicants and apprentices to self-identify as having a disability.

This webinar provided information on when and how to best approach current apprentices, as well as applicants, about this invitation to self-identify as having a disability.
