This webinar provides and overview of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Eligible Training Provider (ETP) performance reporting provisions.

Key Takeaways:

- States are required to submit their completed ETA-9171, which includes performance data on ETP that is collected by the state and the providers.
- 2. There are multiple tools available to assist states in meeting the requirements for reporting ETP performance.
- In addition to reporting ETP performance to DOL, states must also use performance information in the initial and continued eligibility determinations for training providers.
